You and your friends are invited to enjoy the first annual Harbour Heights "Music in the Park" fundraiser to benefit the Environmental Conservancy's Harbour Heights Neighborhood Land Conservation Mission. (See document attached to email with the Bulletin.)

This event, open to the general public, is set for November 5, 2023 from 11 am to 4 pm at the Harbour Heights Park, 27420 Voyageur Drive, Punta Gorda.

Why? Conserving natural land in our neighborhoods allows for the preservation/protection of, education about, and co-existence with, our local native flora and fauna, especially threatened species such as the Gopher Tortoise and Florida Scrub-jay, both of whom live in our community. The Conservancy has permanently protected 6 Scrub-jay zone, land parcels that house 3 Gopher Tortoise burrows in Harbour Heights to date. To continue its Harbour Heights mission, the Conservancy is in need of local citizen support! We hope you'll join us for a variety of music played by local musicians, old-fashioned yard games, access to food trucks, and local environmental learning!
