

The Charlotte Harbor Water Association (CHWA) Distribution System Improvements Project is a public utility project that will replace over 18 miles of old and undersized water mains, install new fire hydrants, isolation valves and water service connections. This will improve water quality, service reliability and increase fire protection in the communities of Harbour Heights and Port Charlotte that surround the Peace River and Charlotte Harbor.

The Distribution System Improvements Project will be divided into three separate project areas, or sections. Currently, the contractor is working in Section 1. No more than two sections will be under construction at the same time.

The contractor is expected to work weekdays from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Some night and weekend work may be necessary to complete emergency repairs. Construction will be concurrent on multiple streets and will move depending upon "shovel-ready" areas. Streets signs will be placed on each street to notify residents of upcoming construction on their street. Week of March 1, 2021

Crews are expected to install water main pipe and perform water main connections on the following streets:

- -- Open cut pipe installation on Highlands Road
- -- Open cut pipe installation on Sounding Drive
- -- Grading on View Drive and Balboa Court
- -- Motorists should expect a daytime road closure and short detour on Highlands Road at Shanahan Lane between Omni Lane and Santa Clara Drive on March 2nd.
- -- Testing of water lines on Discovery Drive
- -- Installation of services on Desoto Drive, Highlands Road, Sounding Drive and Sulstone Drive
- -- Open cut pipe installation on Sulstone Drive

This schedule is subject to change due to inclement weather and unforseen underground conditions. Motorists can expect minor delays while crews progress with construction.
